- After these courses are selected, you as the parents will have the ability to log into the student Real-Time Portal and review the courses.

Students requesting an honors class, who are currently in an honors class and maintain a 90 average at the end of marking period 3, will automatically be enrolled in the desired honors course unless otherwise specified.
