Dear Community Members,

The New Jersey Department of Education has instructed school districts to develop contingency plans for instruction at home in the event that the schools need to close due to a public health-related matter.


In the event that there is a need for a school closure, you will be notified via the District's notification system. Teachers and related service providers have prepared electronic lessons and hard copy assignments relevant to their current curriculum so that education can continue. The goal is to keep the educational process moving forward without having significant breaks in instruction and learning. The District is equipped to provide a valuable educational experience for students through a virtual learning environment, a Distance Learning Plan.

With this in mind, if we should be required to close we have developed the following plan for your child(ren):

- We will follow a "virtual school day" based on a half day schedule, which will provide the necessary four hours of instruction plus additional independent learning activities/homework.
- Teachers and students will follow a half day schedule, similar to what is used on one-session days.
- Students/families in Grades Pre K – 2nd need to respond daily, between the hours of 8:00 AM and 12:30 PM, on an attendance survey that will be posted on Doyle School's website. Hard copy assignments will be collected by teachers upon returning to school.
- Students in Grades 3 through 12 are required to log onto the Google platform daily at the time their class is scheduled to meet.
- Students are asked to log into and log out of Google classroom for each class.
- Teachers will monitor student progress electronically to assist students as they complete their assignments.
- Teachers and Staff will be available to parents and students through email during the half day session hours.
