1.) How will your grade be calculated for the course?

Assessments (tests = 50%, quizzes = 30%) – 80%

Homework – 10%

Classwork/Participation – 10%

2.) What will you need for the class?

- ❖ **Three-ring 2 inch binder** – most of our notes will be printed for you, and keeping them organized is the key to a successful year. If you will be using this binder for other courses as well, I ask that you please get binder dividers to keep the notes separated.
- ❖ **Lined Filler Paper** – for the days that we will be taking handwritten notes
- ❖ **1 Notebook**- this notebook is where your homework will be done each night.
- ❖ **1 Black and White Marble Notebook**- this notebook will be for “Do Now’s” at the start of each class.
- ❖ **Pencils and erasers** – you will make mistakes (and I encourage you to)! Make sure you bring a pencil so you can erase them.
- ❖ **Calculator**- TI-34
- ❖ **NO WORK DONE IN PENS WILL BE ACCEPTED!**

3.) Classroom procedures and rules:

- ❖ **ARRIVE ON TIME** – tardies do you count toward your attendance record, and more importantly are a disruption to the rest of the class. By the time the bell rings, you should have your homework out from the night before, and be ready for class to begin.
- ❖ **DRESS CODE** – **STAY IN IT!** If I see that you are not in dress code, I will ask you once to abide by the dress code rules, after which if you still do not follow the dress code guidelines, I will be writing you up. This write-up will result in you receiving a central detention that same afternoon.
- ❖ **RESPECT** – This goes without saying, but respect your peers, school faculty, your teachers, and the school building. By giving respect, you will receive respect, and the school year will run more smoothly because of it.
- ❖ **CHEATING** – There exists a zero-tolerance policy on cheating in my classroom. What does that mean? If I catch you or suspect you of cheating, you, and the person involved, will both receive a zero for the assignment, with no makeup assignment given. A discipline report will also be sent to administration, and your parent/guardian will be contacted regarding the incident.
- ❖ **ABSENCES** – If you are absent for any reason (excused or unexcused), it is **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to make up the work within **TWO WEEKS TIME FROM THE DATE OF THE ABSENCE**. Until the assignment(s) are made up, your grade will remain a zero. If after two weeks the assignments are not made up, the grade will become a permanent zero. There will be no exceptions made regarding make-ups. When you miss class, you must:
 - 1.) Get any notes you missed from a classmate that attended class the day you were absent as soon as you come back to school.
 - 2.) Come in for help period if you still have any questions regarding the notes you took.

3.) Find out if you had any homework assigned the day you missed class (the answer usually will be yes).

4.) Make up any missed assignments within two weeks of the assignment being given.

- ❖ **BATHROOM** - you will need to sign out and sign in when leaving for bathroom. Only one student allowed out at a time, unless it is an emergency.
- ❖ **HOMEWORK** - will be posted at the back of the classroom everyday. It is to be written down in your homework notebook when you arrive to class. You are to do homework every night when it is assigned. Homework will be posted on Google Classroom each day as well as notes missed if absent. Homework is to be done in your homework notebook. **ALL WORK** is to be shown, no work, **NO CREDIT**.
- ❖ **HELP PERIOD** – I understand that for some students, Math can be a very difficult subject. For that reason, I am always willing to help you understanding anything you may not have while in class. My help period will be held every **Monday-Friday from 7:30-7:50 AM and 2:40-3:15 in room 4**. You are always welcome!
- ❖ **FUN** – You may not always think so, but Math **CAN BE FUN!** My goal is to teach you all that I can this school year, but also make it as interesting as possible. I am looking forward to having a great school year with you, but will need your help in the process. If we can all be respectful, attentive, arrive on time, and be prepared to learn, we can spend more time playing games I've come up with over the years to make learning Math more fun ☺
