
Dear Wood-Ridge School District Community Members,

As we continue to emerge from the restrictions resulting from the COVID-19 Pandemic, we are slowly returning to some sense of normalcy in our school district. I am pleased to announce that there will now be opportunities for parents/guardians of our students to visit the schools in a variety of roles. These roles have historically included PTA Class Parents, Field Trip Chaperones or General Volunteers, as needed. There is a requirement to have completed a fingerprinting and background check process in order to be cleared for this type of service. Any adult previously cleared and approved as a school district chaperone/volunteer retains that eligibility. Since it has been some time since we have had the opportunity to utilize these types of positions, there are probably many of you that have not yet completed the process.

Please note that there is a cost for the process and the cost is the responsibility of the applicant and not the school district.
