The Mayor and Council and the Board of Education have embarked on a project to expand and renovate Doyle School. The project will increase classroom space for general education which will lower class sizes district-wide in grades K to 6, increase classroom space for special education, allow for an expanded Pre-K program, and provide bathrooms in all Pre-K and Kindergarten classrooms.

We are very excited to report that Wood-Ridge was awarded a \$12,500,000 State Budget Grant for this project!

The expansion will provide 18 new classrooms, 8 of which will have bathrooms and be used for Kindergarten. It will also include a new Gym, a new Kitchen for the cafeteria, a new Faculty Room, a new Child Study Team Office and 2 new Small Group Instruction Classrooms.

Work will also be performed in the existing Doyle School. It will include renovating the Media Center, the Art Room, and student bathrooms, installing a new security vestibule and an elevator to the lower level, and adding new bathrooms in 2 existing classrooms that currently do not have bathrooms.

When complete Doyle will have a total of 46 classrooms: 15 with bathrooms for grades Pre-K and Kindergarten, 22 for grades 1 to 4, 8 for small group instruction and/or self-contained special education, and 1 for Art.

The project will also include expanded parking lots and a new playground. Work will begin this winter and be completed by September 2025. We will continue to provide updates as the project progresses.
